What We're Learning

Language Arts:

- Handwriting-Aa, Tt, Mm, and Nn

Math:

- Writing numbers 0-5
- Counting to 20 by ones, and counting up to 20 from a given number (ex. 14-20)
- Counting up to 10 objects and explaining how we counted-move and count, touch each one, counting on
- Identifying the penny and nickel
